Dear Friends!

I am happy to present you annual report 2018. Last year was full of interesting events and projects for Social Development Foundation «Samruk-Kazyna Trust».

We implemented 57 projects in 2018 and total coverage rate was 350 000 beneficiaries.

Together with our partners «Dara» Foundation, we opened psycho-pedagogical and resource centers within the framework of the project «Different-Equal» for children with special education needs to engage in comfortable conditions. 209 children with severe diagnoses incurable in Kazakhstan were sent for treatment to foreign clinics. More than 1,5 thousand children have free access to art and educational clubs, and sports classes in neighbourhood clubs of the capital. 15 graduates of orphanages got a new profession and with it a foot in the door. For instance, 50 sports facilities were set nationwide. More than 300 000 Kazakhstan citizens were engaged in sports thanks to «Different you!» project. Volunteers of «Zhenis» project surrounded with care 1200 veterans of World War II in 31 cities of Kazakhstan. More than 40 000 Kazakhstanis were entitled to a free medical examination through the «Medical trains» project. 265 non-profit organizations of the country were trained in social entrepreneurship «ƏREKET» project,

96 of them received grants for the development of their business. This year we continued a close interaction with non-governmental organizations and local executive bodies for more efficient workin group of companies of Samruk-Kazyna JSC regions. I note that the experience of the transition from targeted assistance to social investment that is implemented in the Foundation, allows you to get multiplicative effect for society in general.

In addition, last year our foundation began to pay more attention to educational work, including training of non-commercial organizations. Besides educational on-site trainings as a part of social entrepreneurship development project «ƏREKET», we also included conducting webinars online. Moreover, official Foundation site was supplemented by new functional and now it contains more educational content, which is updated on a continual basis.

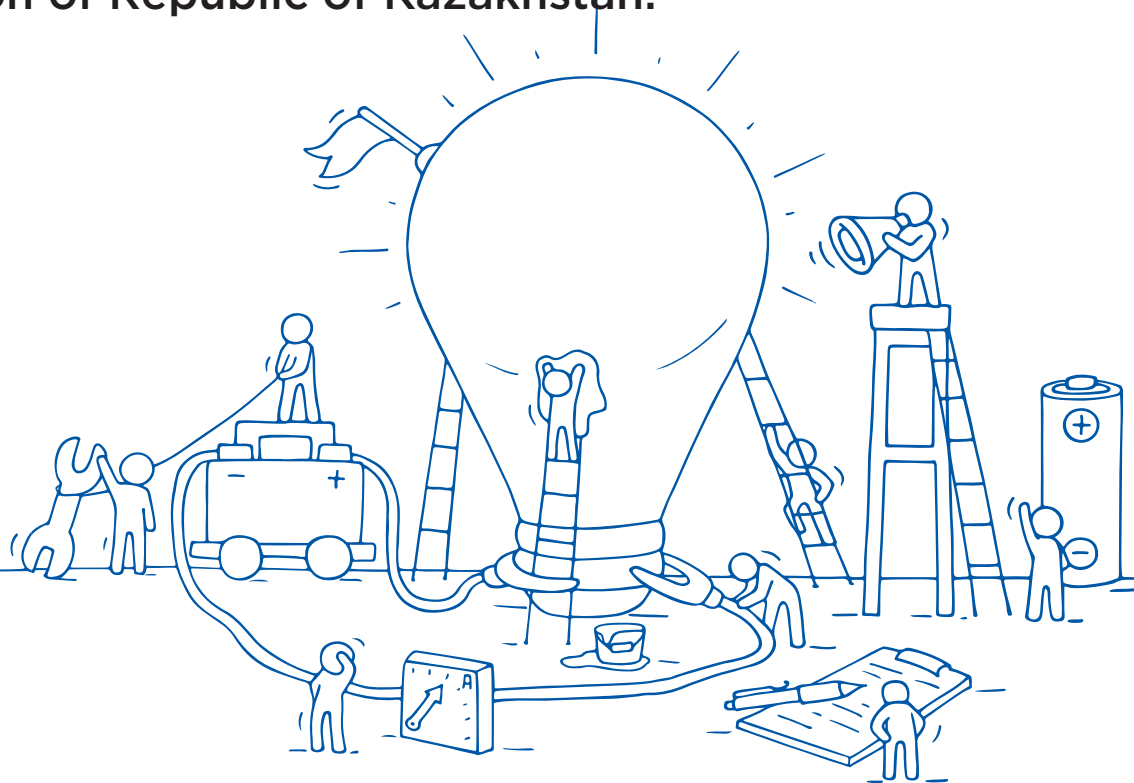
Format of podcasts, expert interviews and copyright materials from examiners in the philanthropic work was implemented. They publish their articles on international information venues, participate in conferences and forums dedicated to social support. In addition, foundation employees are involved in all projects, by forging comprehensive communications with stakeholders. Last year, certainly, there

was a lot of work done, but Social Development Foundation «Samruk-Kazyna Trust» does not intend to stop there. There are many projects waiting for realization ahead. All of this would have been impossible without our team of specialists, who contributed not only professionalism and knowledge, but also a heart in each project. Let me thank project administrators, whose concern for society results in our big joint projects, which change the lives of our compatriots.

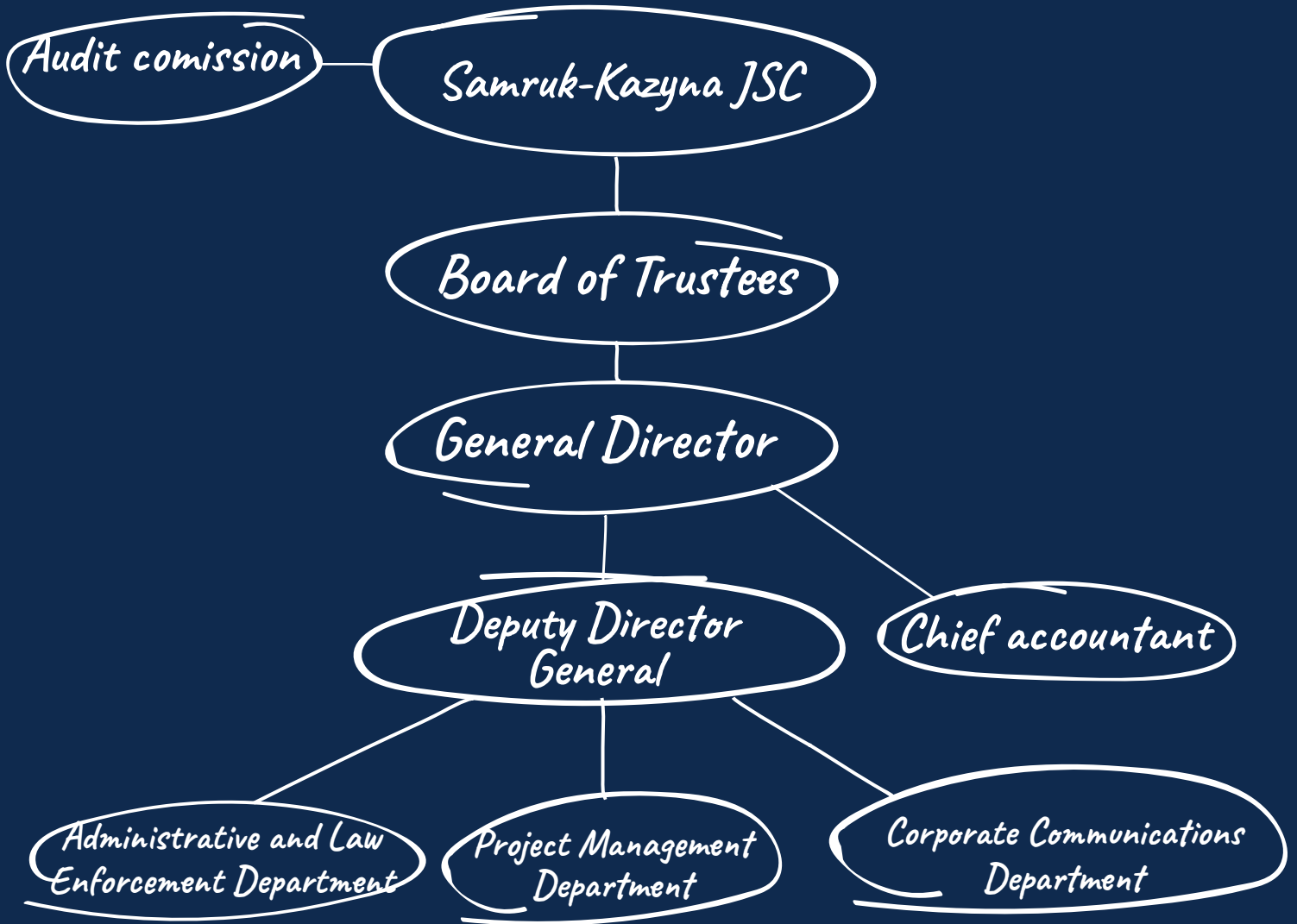

Last year Foundation continued the work on development of mass sports. Thus, «Different you!» challenge got a great response, it united more than 300 000 Kazakhstan citizens around itself. Current project was supported by the Head of the State Nursultan Nazarbayev. Project of installation of sports grounds have been also encouraged: 52 grounds for sports were installed in 10 regions of the country.

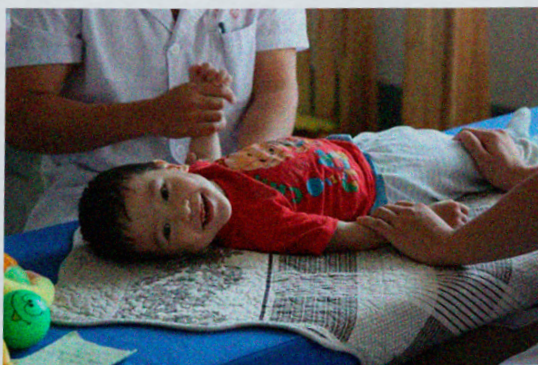

Social Development Foundation «Samruk-Kazyna Trust» implemented 57 socially significant projects in next directions: assistance in social and medical sectors, media development, cultural community, human potential, strengthening of labor relations and investment in sustainable development of society, realization of Social Investment Program «Menin Elm».



1627 children with cerebral palsy were rehabilitated

thanks to the project "Healthy Children", implemented jointly with the foundation of "Kashietti Zhol" Foundation. The project is being re-deployed since 2015.



96 grants earmarked for social entrepreneurship

«REKET» project received many positive reviews. 265 representatives from 180 non-commercial organizations passed education on social entrepreneurship. 96 grants were earmarked.



1200 VETERANS OF GREAT WORLD WAR RECEIVED TARGETED ASSISTANCE

When implementing projects aimed at children, «Samruk-Kazyna Trust» does not forget about elder population of the country. Special attention is traditionally given on care of veterans of GWW. In 2018, 4 770 voluntary raids were organized to them. 1200 veterans of GPW received targeted

assistance in the form of products, medicine and cleaning. Besides that, participants and invalids of GWW, as well as front laborers are provided with free railway transport among Kazakhstan and countries of CIS.

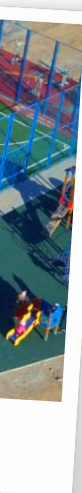

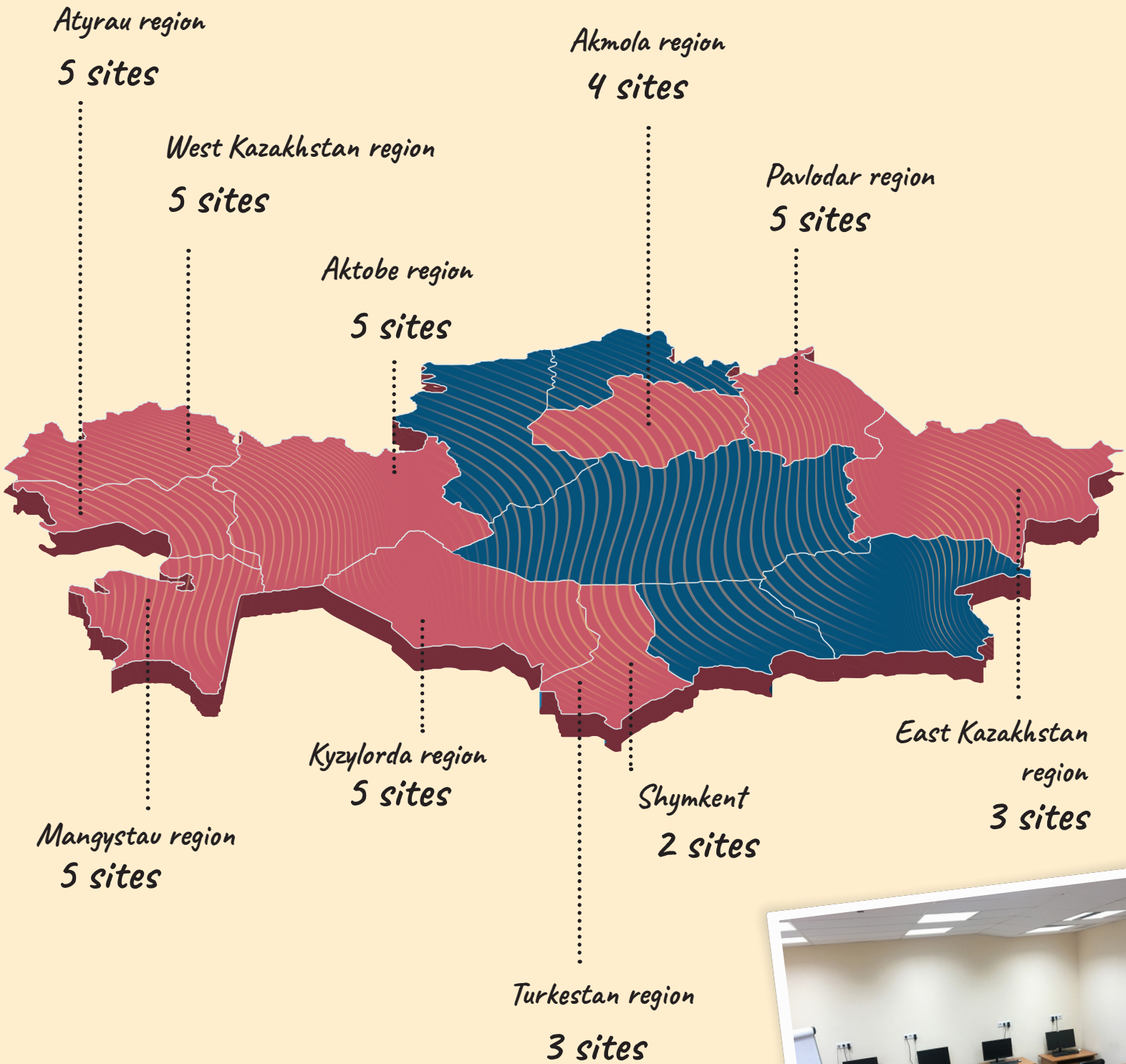

Project is aimed at creation of universal sports and children playgrounds, necessary for strengthening physical health of the population, organization of leisure activities for children and younger generation.

2 *Equipment of 10 general educational schools by computers. Zhanaozen city*

Project is aimed at creating and improving physical infrastructure of general education schools of Zhanaozen by fitting 10 general education schools with computers (Zhanaozen).

Every school got 12 computers for students and one computer per teacher. Purchased computers will help students get more knowledge for the new school year. Coverage of students in grades 5-11 in 10 general education schools amounted to more than 8,400 pupils. In addition, number of schools are planning to include «Informatics» subject from grade 3rd grade.

people were not confused and quickly turned it to a hockey court - cool idea, because in our Pavlodar winter lasts five months!

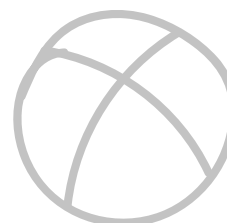
There is a children playground besides the field - children from all over the area come here at warm season. You bet!

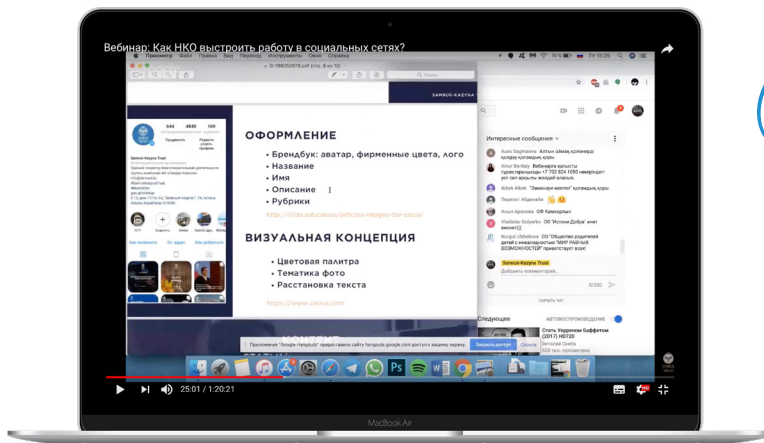

Rosa Kusainova 55 years, Pavlodar

Rosa Satvaldinovna is famous among all Pavlodar region as a competent massage therapist, defectologist, working with children with VBCs (cerebral palsy). Parents of kids don't come to her only for professional massage therapy, but also for kind word. She finds an individual approach to each child. «One slip can aggravate the situation, that's why we never hurry, we begin to develop hands and legs gradually», she says. Her path of massage therapist began 20 years ago, when she became a mother of child with VBCs herself. For a young woman it would have sounded as a bolt from the blue, but she wasn't going to give up. «We walked through a lot of doctors, passed rehabilitation courses one after another. I stood next to each specialist and memorized every movement to help my son Aitim at home», says Rose.



Woman began to engage in gymnastics to show an example to Aytim and looking at her, he gradually began to get involved in sports too.

In 2018 Aytim and his mom became the participants of «ƏREKET» project, where they were successfully educated, protected the project, got a grant and opened a massage room.

Rosa Kusainovna provides chargeable massage services as well as free for children from disadvantaged segments of the population.

Gulmira Batpakulova 40 years, Ural'sk

Gulmira graduated her school in 1995 and went to higher educational establishments. Inspired yesterday's graduate dreamed about entering the university, getting higher education, and settling at work...

Nonetheless, this dreams were not destined to come true. On her way to the town a young woman got into the car accident and injured her spine. Next four years she received a treatment and passed a rehabilitation on restoration of vital and motor functions. 5 years after the accident Gulmira entered Institute-13 on accounting courses, in 2001 she graduated driver courses, in 2002 she graduated seamstress courses and a year later - hairdresser. All of this was achieved despite the fact that she was confined to a wheelchair. The desire to get a higher education never faded and soon Gulmira entered the West Kazakhstan Humanities University named after M.Utemisov on educational psychologist.

In so doing, young lady actively participated in public life and in 2009 together with the initiative group they opened a Public Association «Society for people with disabilities



of musculoskeletal system «ARBA». The mission of organization is protection of the rights and legitimate interests of people with impaired functions of musculoskeletal system.

Contribution to the creation of barrier-free active ageing with impaired functions of the bone and muscular system. OA «Arba» became the grant winner of «ƏREKET» in summer of 2018. With these funds they acquired equipment for repairing wheelchairs. Today project provides social services to the population.

In addition, organization of veteran asset work in order to host events to raise patriotism of younger generation, improvement of life conditions of Great Patriotic War veterans, cooperation in memorialization of Fatherland Defenders, strengthening peace and friendship between nations, representation of veteran interests in State bodies.

Zhenis is a project of countrywide scale focused on strengthening patriotic spirit of Kazakhstani society, disseminating spiritual and moral values, educating respect to history and feats of veterans.

Continuous care for veterans is promoted, year-round targeted and material assistance is provided to all Great Patriotic War participants living in Kazakhstan.

Assistance provided:

- House cleaning, home help;
- Accompany to a doctor;
- Purchase of medicines and food;
- Cooking;
- Other assistance.

- When I think about Victory, I understand with what difficulty it was gained. Our grandparents fought through tears and pain for our free and happy present. Probably the least I can do to help our heroes is to gift them a little warmth and joy, help and attention. It is important for me that veterans at the sunset of their long and hard path would have all conditions for comfortable life.

It is obvious that they all have different needs: someone needs house cleaning, someone products or medicine and someone is happy with an ordinary conversation with volunteers and a cup of tea.

For example, the thing that I like the most is cooking lunch and listening to war stories. To gain the trust of veterans, volunteers of the project always call in advance and warn at what time exactly they will come. It is very important that the volunteer should be in a t-shirt, because most of the veterans don't remember the face, but remember the bright color of the t-shirt and its logo with a picture of a star.



Finally yet importantly, it is relevant to visit veterans not one time, but every month: when you visit them more frequent they trust you more. The «Letter to the veteran» was launched in the framework of «Zhenis» in 2016. Kazakhstan citizens wrote words of appreciation and poetries to veterans. Volunteers of the project sent 1100 letters to 22 cities of Kazkhstan in 2017. They read them and veterans listened references from people all over the country with tears in their eyes. This was very touching experience, which I will remember for a long period.

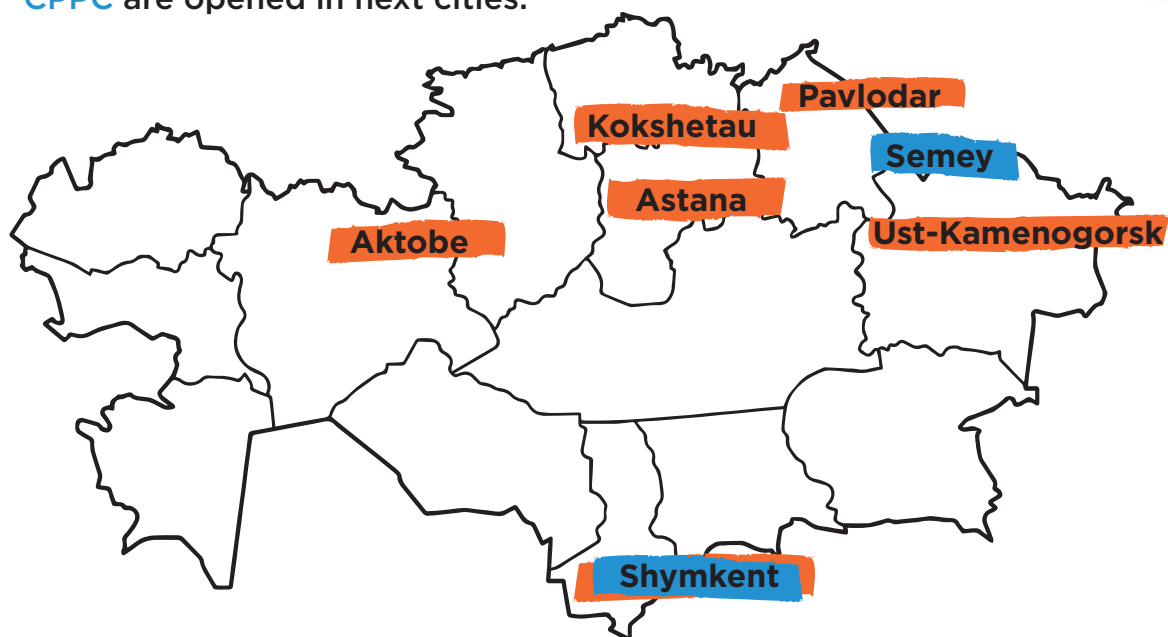

Sabina Temirbayeva

7 years, Aktobe

Sabina is desired and long awaited child. She was born for a period of 33 weeks before prescribed date. Account went for seconds: suddenly started childbirth, road to the maternity hospital and preparation for operation. Unborn Sabina was gasping in the womb of mother, she did not have enough oxygen. Doctors managed to save the girl but next 5 days she was connected to breathing machine. Sabina started to breath by herself only on 6th day. Before 7 months she grew up and developed normally but when she was 8, her mother started to get worried because a child was not able to sit.

Asphyxia had its effect and reflected on an atrophied feet tonicity. When Sabina was 2 years, she was diagnosed with cerebral palsy-

spastic diplegia of the lower limbs, which was like a thunder among the clear sky. Nevertheless, it did not break the spirit of Temirbaev family. They started to go through enhanced rehabilitation and treatment. When it was time to go to school, Sabina's parents gave her to the preschool training in the CPPC in Aktobe.

There girl was engaged in physical and music therapy, passed courses with speech therapist, psychologist, defectologist and received a general massage.



Sabina even became a participant of a jug band, which became the winner of international contest «Tonic».

Listening to opinion of CPPC specialists, parents decided to give her to general education school and on the 1st September of 2018 she entered secondary school in Aktobe, on the basis of which was launched a Resource center of inclusive education. Apart from obligatory lessons from school program, girl continues to have courses with speech therapist, psychologist and defectologist.

Sabina always stays in the center of attention, she made friends with a lot of people. Her parents understood that they made a right choice and that their child has same opportunities as others. All Temirbayev family is sure that their daughter will get back on her feet and will run with her classmates!

Project is aimed at **providing free rehabilitation** help to children with cerebral palsy and other dysfunctions of bone and muscular system through organization of rehabilitation courses for orphans, children without parents, incomplete, low-income and multi-children families.

1627 children went through rehabilitation in 3 Rehabilitation Centers (RC), funded by Samruk-Kazyna Trust and fundraising.

In addition, administrators drew 90 million tenge in 2018 and they were directed on children rehabilitation. Charity event was conducted on the 8th of November of 2018 in honour of anniversary opening of RC «KZhol Shymkent» in Shymkent, in which charity event was held.

As a result, 15 000 000 million tenge was collected and sent for repair and arrangement of zero floor of RC building, where new treatment rooms will be organized.

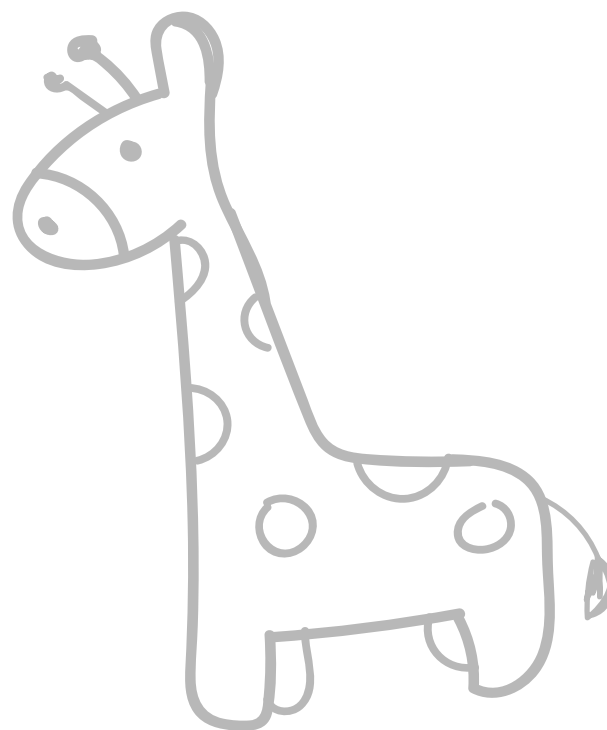

Zhanerke suffers from VBCs of spastic-hyperkinetic form of severe degree. It is hard for her to sit in the wheelchair and her hands doesn't always respond to her wishes, legs take strongest cramps. First thing she was taught in RC «Kasietty Zhol» was to discover oneself and features of own body. She learned to relax in wheelchair because she was there most of the time. The girl is 13 years old. She had a huge desire to go to school, though in perspective she only had an opportunity of homeschool. RC had heard about Zhanerke's dream and began to act. First of all, a series of surveys were conducted and showed that she is preserved intellectually. The team decided to work on her preparation for school. They taught Zhanerke the alphabet, how



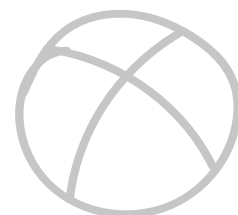
to type on the planshet, sort out in seasons, lay out pictures by the plot and show the right answers by her look. It was time to consider the issues whether to define her in correctional school or not. With a help of the President of the Foundation, Zhanerke was invited to interview and examination in school! When the school found out that Zhanerke studied more than 3 months in RC «Kasietty Zhol», they said:

«Yes, if the specialists look with hope, it means they believe in her». There were no limit to our happiness, when the specialist came out and said that she will be enrolled at the first grade of the school because she knows most of the things and she is a clever girl.

When this news reached our father, he bought a school uniform the next day. For someone a school uniform is a routine feature, but for our girl's parents as well as for herself it is an enormous achievement and symbol of a dream came true! She graduated 1st grade and the teachers board of school decided to transfer her to the 4th.

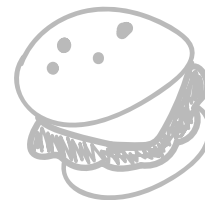
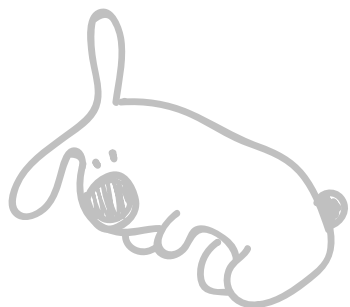
Irina Chistyakova

There are different people coming to SOS Family Support Center of Children Village of Temirtau, each of them has its own special and complicated story, but at the same time they are united by one thing - families that aspire to be happy, families where parents seek to become the closest caring and loving person to their children. Irina is a mother of two children, very warm, spiritual, tremulous and at the same time a person, who manages to protect oneself and closest people. She is nurturing a nephew now, who, due to certain circumstances was left without parent care. Not looking at the young age, her nephew Valera is

fully independent and can stand up for himself. He had to grow up early because his parents paid more attention to their selves than to him. When Irina became a guardian of Valera, he was 4,5 years old. She was concerned that the boy could not count, did not know the letters, badly distinguished colors and could not pronounce most of the sounds. She was even more concerned that he was restless. He needed help in coping with what he has been through recently. That is why she requested the assistance of Family Support Center.



Irina is an active participant of all programs: trainings, master-classes, family leisure programs, art therapeutical classes and education in the School of Adoptive Parents. She was respectful to everything because she took it as an opportunity to become more wise, understanding, knowing and managing parent. Together with Valera she participated in cintests, drew and sculpt, composed fairytales and performs different tasks. Irina is a good organizer and during leisure programs, she united other children, project participants, around herself. All of this gave Valera a reason to be proud by his grandmother; he also tried and learned a lot during this time to make her happy with his achievements.

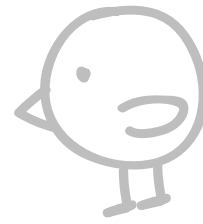

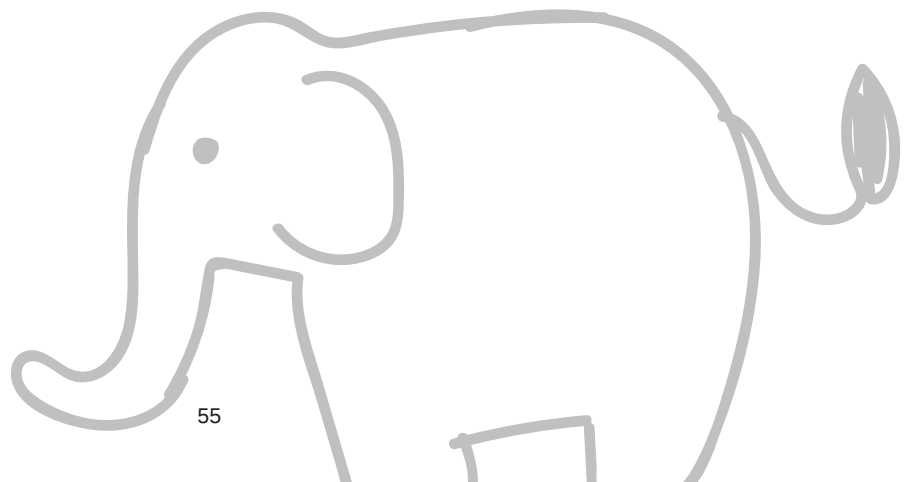

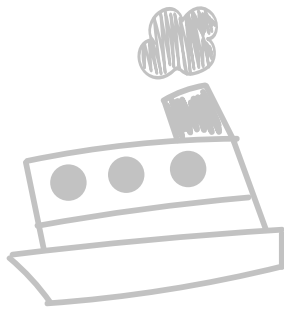
Azamat Pasyrov 9 years, Zhanaozen

Azamat has a very rare illness called Mobius Syndrome. In other words, complete face paralysis. Mimic emotions are absent: boy cannot smile, frown or open mouth widely. In addition, partial paralysis of his tongue causes speech disorder. He has an eyeball paralysis, which is why his eyes are limited in movement to left and right. From the first days of life, Azamat spent most of the time in medical institutions, but doctors could not make an accurate diagnosis. According to their prognosis, he was destined to stay deeply disabled. Contrary to assurances of doctors, Azamat's mother did not give up. She attended treatment courses, worked hard with him and a miracle happened: at the age of 1 year and 7

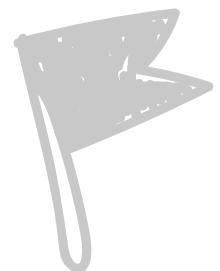
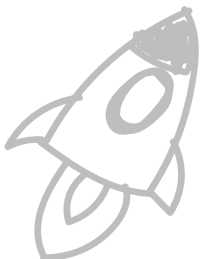


months Azamat began to walk and after 1,5 year he began to talk. Boy had a plastic surgery on alignment and correction of strabismus in 2014. He is not able to swallow, chew, blink, speak clearly yet. All of this is dangerous because in the nearest time Azamat's face will swell down. Skin will sag down weighting down eyelids and cheeks.

As doctors say, in 2-3 years, the process will be irreversible, but thanks to the project «Gift of life to Children», Azamat began a treatment course in Russia, where specialists successfully cure children with similar diagnoses. They transplant slender muscles from thighs to the left and right sides of the face for smile recovery. In result face revives, mouth and lips start to function like most. Facial expressions appear and child is able to close lips, speak better and smile. Azamat is only in the beginning of his way, but we believe that everything will work out.

Sanzhar was born in Almaty on June 24 of 2009. Now he is 9 years old. First time Sanzhar's parents found out about autism-connected problems when he was 2 years old: he did not respond to his name, did not react to people, did not understand what someone said to him and didn't look in the eyes when he played with other children. When he was 1 year old, he learned how to walk by himself, but was motor-disinhibited. He slept a little in the morning, but ran and jumped practically nonstop. Sanzhar's mother noticed that he chose food very selectively: some products every day. He was almost never interested in toys or lost interest very fast. When he was 2,5 years old his parents began to take him to psychologist, defectologist and speech therapist. He was diagnosed

with autism and year after he came to «Defeating autism» project. Project attendance has borne fruit: on the first week, Sanzhar started to respond to his name. Second by second, he was getting better; Sanzhar started to notice the world around, develop life skills (wash the floor, dust, and sweep). He began to notice and hear other people and participate in all active collaborative events (relay races, games, hikes, walks).

Now boy has big changes. He attends first inclusive football club «Ansau». There is lot of work ahead for sure, but results give hope and desire to move on.

Investigation

Investigation on subject of the problem of promotion of job qualifications was held under vocational orientation of students of senior year (by example of 9th grades of schools of South Kazakhstan, Mangystau, Pavlodar, Aktobe and West Kazakhstan regions)

Investigation results:

1. 29 % of students of 9th grades from five regions never faced with "job qualifications". Those, who did had neutral associations ("ordinary study place").
2. Number of students, who want to go to college increased from 30% to 35% after training. Modestly, but interest to information about local colleges increased. In general, number of aware students was increased.
3. After participating in trainings, number of parents who agreed to get job qualification for their children increased from 30,8% to 35,4%. Support from parent side about entering college increased from 44% to 48%. Parents' interest about job qualifications in local colleges was also increased.
4. After training, number of students who think that employee with high qualification has a good perspective for employment was increased (from 58% to 64%); in addition, that job qualification is a good start to professional and career growth (from 58% to 62%).
5. Parents have changed their mind about job qualifications after the training. Number of those, who think that these professions are low-paid, decreased from 33% to 24%. Number of parents, who thought that job qualifications, does not have any perspective also decreased (from 24% to 19%).

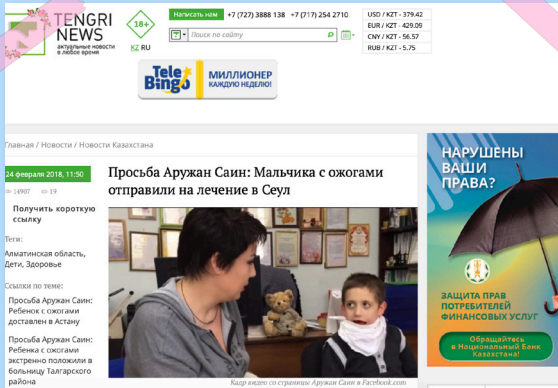

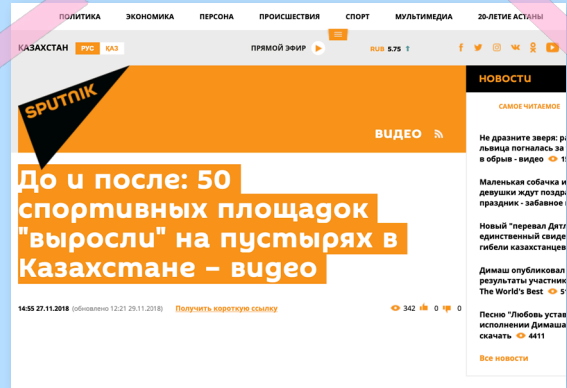
